# **EDGERTON PARKS & RECREATION**



## CENTRAL PARK

Located in the heart of Edgerton, Central Park contains a children's play structure, basketball courts and a swimming pool complex. Part of the City's bike path also runs through Central Park. Picnic tables, the historic band shelter, and the Saunder's Creek footbridge are also part of this stunning park.

## RACETRACK PARK

Named for the horse races that were held there years ago, this park is located on the northwest side of the City. The park contains baseball diamonds, soccer fields, playground equipment, a concession stand, and a deer pen. Two enclosed pavilions may be rented for family gatherings by calling the Edgerton City Hall at (608) 884-3341.

#### DOG PARKS

Dogs are welcome in the 15+ acre off-leash area located in the Edgerton Business Park and the fenced in area on-Winston Drive. Dog must be up to date on their rabies vaccinations and licensed in the City of Edgerton.

# **POOL**

Visitors to the Edgerton pool will enjoy a double-decker pool with waterslides, diving boards, and zero depth entry pool. The pool area is complete with concessions, changing room, and a sandy play area.

# VOTER REGISTRATION

In order to vote, you must be a US Citizen, at least 18 years old and have been living in your voting district for at least 28 days prior to the election. Proof of residency is required to register. Polls are located at city hall and are open on election days from 7 AM to 8 PM.

## WATER AND SEWER BILLS

Upon renting or purchasing a home, please call the utility office to set up a water/sewer account at 608-884-3341. The bills are mailed quarterly.







## ANIMALS

A license is required for dogs and cats five months or older. The license period runs January 1st-December 31st, but owners have until March 31st to obtain a license without penalty. Proper tags should always be worn by licensed animals. License applications can be acquired at City Hall and must be accompanied by the certificate of rabies vaccinations

# **CITY SERVICES**

## TRASH COLLECTION

Trash should be placed in containers provided by the City, one recycling and one refuse. All materials should be curbside by 6:00 AM on the day of pickup. For large item pick-up, please call Badgerland Disposal at (608) 580-0580 to request a pick-up the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month. Visit the City's website for collection day schedule.



## RECYCLING COLLECTION

All recyclable items must be placed in the 95 gallon bin provided by the City. Bins must be placed curbside prior to 6:00 AM every other week according to Waste Management's schedule. All recycling can be co-mingled except the following items:

- 1. Batteries (Drop off at City garage)
- 2. Electronics (2 drop-off events per year)
- 3. Motor Oil (Drop off at City garage)

## BRUSH AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Beginning in the spring and continuing through early fall, weather permitting. The City collects brush and branches on the first Tuesday of the month. Please do not place limbs and branches curbside more than 72 hours prior to pickup. Please call the Public Works Director at 608-884-4037 for more information.

## **OPEN BURNING**

Opening burning is allowed in a grill, fireplace, or campfire in an open pit where the cooking surface and/or campfire surface is less than 25 sq ft. Materials to be burned shall be limited to wood logs and charcoal briquettes. Garbage, refuse, or recyclable materials cannot be burned.



## SNOW & ICE REMOVAL

Each owner or occupant is responsible for clearing snow and ice that accumulates on public sidewalks of adjoining property within 24 hours of snowfall. If a person neglects to clear the snow from a public sidewalk, the city will clear the snow and will bill the homeowner.
