- Industrial TIF
- Expenditures for life of TIF to date: 72% for infrastructure; 2.7% for development incentive as part of public private agreements
- Expenditure period is expired
- The City Council extended the life of the TIF for one year to provide funding for affordable housing initiatives.

TIF #6 Downtown TIF:

- Rehabilitation/conservation TIF
- Expenditures for life of TIF to date: 47% for infrastructure; 46% for development incentive as part of public private agreements
- Very active regarding projects/expenditures
- Potential donor to TIF #7

TIF #7 "Dorsey" TIF

- Industrial TIF
- Expenditures for life of TIF to date: 40% for infrastructure; 32% for development incentive as part of public private agreements
- Inactive regarding expenditures
- Designated a distressed TIF
- Could be a recipient of donation from TIF #6

TIF #8 West side TIF

- Mixed use TIF
- Expenditures for life of TIF to date: 44% for infrastructure; 42% for development incentive as part of public private agreements
- Street construction, land purchase, and storm pond project planned for 2020.
