**These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the City of Edgerton.**

**REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

On or about May 19, 2023 the City of Edgerton will authorize Edgerton Community Outreach to submit a request to the HUD for the release of Community Planning and Development, Community Project Funding Grant funds under the Community Project Funds (CPD) FY 2023, as amended, to undertake a project known as 210 West Fulton Street for the purpose of rehabilitating an existing structure and constructing a small addition and parking lot for the following: six veterans housing units, and veterans and senior meeting space. The total estimated project cost is \$2.1 million and is located at 210 West Fulton Street.

**FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

The City of Edgerton has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the City of Edgerton City Hall at 12 Albion Street, Edgerton WI 53534 and may be examined or copied weekdays 7:30 A.M to 4:00 P.M.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the City of Edgerton office of the City Administrator. All comments received by May 18, 2023 will be considered by the City of Edgerton prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION**

The City of Edgerton certifies to HUD that Ramona Flanigan in her capacity as City Administrator consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Edgerton Community Outreach to use Program funds.

## **OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS**

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Edgerton's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Edgerton; (b) the City of Edgerton has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be sent to CPD\_COVID-19OEE-MIL@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
