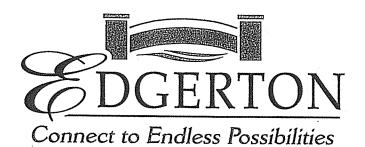

#### OCTOBER 2019

- 1. Daily lab work.
- 2. D.N.R. reports.
- 3. Did sewer and lift station checks.
- 4. General-plant maintenance was done.
- 5. Did phosphorus and ammonia sampling for D.N.R. reports.
- 6. Mowed the grass at the plant and all sewer easements.
- 7. Preventative maintenance is being done on the collection system leading to the plant by jet-cleaning lines and root cutting if necessary.
- 9. Removed the UV lights from the disinfection tank and shut down the system as required by the DNR. The lights have been cleaned and the old fluid flushed out and all new fluid pumped back in the wiper system. The lights will be ready to go back inservice next spring.
- 10. Alliant Energy was changing the power source to the Hospital Lift Station. We cleaned out the tank and pumped out the liquid they said it would be about a 4 hour change over. All went well with no trouble.
- 11. Sent the Bobcat in to be serviced it was making some unusual noise. They had to replace the drive belt and the tensioner arm. The also did the yearly maintenance checkup.
- 12. Pulled the pumps at the Hospital Lift Station change the oil.
- 13. Still no word on the digester blower #3, Dave Sauer is working on this.
- 14. Checked on all building heaters and turned on the required panel heaters, get things ready for winter.

- 1. Monthly samples were taken to the State Lab of Hygiene. All samples were safe.
- 2. Both samples taken at the East Tower came back as safe. The tower was put back into service on 10-7. There have been no issues.
- 3. Cross connection inspections were done.
- 4. Old meters were changed.
- 5. The chlorine and fluoride pumps at #3 wellhouse needed some maintenance. Both working fine.
- 6. Old meters were taken apart. The brass will be taken to Stateline Recycling sometime in the near future.
- 7. The door switches that control the exhaust fan at #2 had to be remounted. We had to drill and tap the top of the door frame to secure the switches. This was the last step after the building was repaired after getting hit by a car.
- 8. Locates were done.
- 9. The swimming pool was filled to winter level.
- 10. Mowing and weed control were done.
- 11. Monthly DNR report was submitted.
