PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Chair Jim Burdick called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. Committee members present were Jim Burdick and Casey Langan. Also present were City Administrator Ramona Flanigan, Municipal Services Director Howard Moser and Mayor Christopher Lund.

Sarah Braun was absent.

Moser confirmed the agendas were properly posted on Friday, September 17, 2021 at the Post Office, Edgerton Library, and City Hall.

APPROVE MINUTES: A Burdick/Langan motion to approve the August 25, 2021 Public Works Committee minutes passed on a 2/0 roll call vote.

DISCUSS DANE COUNTY NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING PROBLEM STATEMENT: Staff reviewed a draft problem statement for the Dane County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.

A Burdick/Langan motion to approve problem statement and submit as is passed, all in favor.

DISCUSS SIDEWALK OR BIKE PATH ON RIVER ROAD: Staff discussed a resident's request to the possibility of having a sidewalk or bike path on River Road. Staff will investigate ideas and expense then come back to the committee with some options.

DISCUSS 2022 BUDGET: Staff reviewed the 2022 budget capital requests with the committee and recommended they be included in the Council.

Being no other business before the Committee, a Burdick/Langan motion to adjourn passed, all voted in favor.

Dane County Hazard Mitigation Plan: The last step the City needs to take regarding the Dane County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is the Mitigation Strategy Worksheet. This supports the Committee's approved mitigation Problem Statement related to flooding. The planning process requires the City provide an opportunity for public input. A notice has been provided for this meeting inviting the community to comment on the plan.

Speed on S Main Street: Some citizens suggested reducing the speed limit on S Main Street as a means of reducing speeding. Current speed limits traveling north (coming into the City) on S Main are as follows and as shown on the attached map:

- 1 - A warning sign indicating a reduced speed to 35 mph (current speed at this point 55 mph)
- 2 – 35 mph sign
- 3 – 25 mph warning sign
- 25 mph

The Rock County DPW Director indicates we could request the County Board reduce speeds by no more than 10 mph. Any greater decreases require DOT approval.

If the objective is to reduce speeds in front of the cemeteries, then a speed reduction request should be made to the County Board. The Committee should decide if they will also request a reduction in speed from 55 to 45 mph south of the cemeteries.

If the objective is to encourage traffic to obey the current posted speed limits, the most effective mechanism would be a flashing speed sign at the start of the 25 mph section, not a reduction in speed in front of the cemeteries.

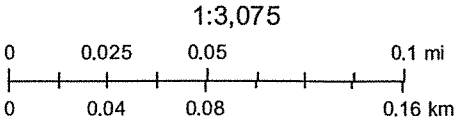
