Additional DPW Part time — The Public Works Director has requested to keep two temporary employees through the end of October. The estimated cost of having 2 employees work an additional 9 weeks each is \$5,800. After the week ending August 26, there should be approximately \$1,400 remaining in the 2017 budget for part time employees. The \$4,400 shortfall is available from the sale of DPW equipment that was not included in the budget. The Committee should decide if the excess sale of city property funds can be utilized for part time wages.
